# **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### 1. **PREPARATION OF BIDS:**

- **Submittal of Bids:** Bids delivered by a) the U. S. Postal Service should be addressed to: Ingram State Technical College, ATTN: Purchasing, P.O. Box 220350, Deatsville, AL 36022. Bids delivered by special courier service should be addressed to: Ingram State Technical College, ATTN: Purchasing, 5375 Ingram Rd., Deatsville, AL 36022. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the bid number and bid opening date on the outside of the envelope. All information shall be entered in ink, typewritten or computer generated in the appropriate space on the forms. An authorized company representative must sign bid in ink. All bids must be notarized.
- b) Receipt of Bids: The Purchasing
  Department is not responsible for
  timely delivery of the U.S. or private
  courier mail. The bidder is responsible
  to allow adequate mailing time,
  including time for interoffice mail
  delivery, or to take appropriate
  alternate steps to assure their bid is
  delivered to the Purchasing
  Department by the specified due date
  and time. Late bids will not be
  considered.
- c) Taxes: Bid prices shall not include tax.
  Tax exemption certificates shall be
  furnished upon written request.
- d) Freight Terms: All items shall be bid FOB destination with all transportation charges prepaid and included in the bid prices. The successful bidder shall assume responsibility of all liability/ responsibility for damage in transit. It is the responsibility of the bidder to inspect the facilities (grounds, road access, and building) for delivery method, installation and/or set-up of materials, supplies and/or equipment.

- e) Shipping Charges: all applicable shipping and handling costs must be included in the pricing submitted with the bid. All shipping charges shall be the same as stated for all campus locations for the college and must be stated in the bid.
- f) Item Specifications: Specifications in this bid may reference manufacturers' products and list their model or part numbers, followed by the words "or equivalent." These references are for identification purposes only and in no way are intended to eliminate or discourage the offering of substitute items which would exceed or equal the specifications.
  - i) Any item bid as an equivalent which lacks sufficient descriptive literature or technical information to enable complete comparative analysis, may be disqualified.
  - ii) Include literature

    detailing each equivalent item.
    The bid line item must be

When brand name or catalog number is not stated by the bidder, it is understood the offer is exactly as specified.

#### 2. AWARDING CONDITIONS

- a) Acceptance and Withdrawal of Bids:
  A bid will not be accepted by the
  Purchasing Department after the time
  and date specified for receipt of bid
  proposals.
- b) **Bid Prices Duration:** Bids shall be awarded within ninety (90) days of the bid opening. Bid prices shall remain in effect for a minimum of ninety (90)

days from the bid opening unless requested for a longer period of time in the **Invitation to Bid**.

Bid prices are to remain in effect for one year from the award date. The contract may be extended for a period of two additional years if no changes are made in the specifications and/or pricing by the vendor. The College and the vendor must agree in writing for the contract extension.

- c) Amendment & Cancellation: The college reserves the right to cancel, recall and /or reissue all, or any part, of this bid at any time. Bids will be awarded in a manner which appears to be in the best interest of the college. Awards may be issued to multiple bidders.
- d) **Rejection of Bids:** A bid may be rejected by the Purchasing Department if it is non-responsive or the bidder is determined to be not responsible.
- e) The college will not accept prepay terms for the items and services in this bid.
- f) **Method of Award:** The responsibility of determining the acceptability of any products offered rest solely with the College.
  - By item: Each item in the bid will be awarded individually to the lowest responsible bidder.
  - ii) All or None by Category,
    Group or Section: the bid will

- g) **Packaging:** Successful bidders must provide packing slips detailing quantity, size, color and description of each item shipped.
- h) Authorization to Perform Under a Contract: All purchases must be properly authorized in advance through the Purchasing Department.

Vendors must first obtain a printed J. F. Ingram purchase order before commencing performance under a contract.

## 3. CLARIFICATION OF SPECIFICATIONS

Questions of a technical nature may be referred to other individuals for an appropriate response as deemed necessary. Answers to such requests will be given to all recorded vendors, in addendum form, which will be included as part of the contract documents.

# 4. **AGREEMENT**

- a) Non Collusion: The vendor, by affixing its signature to the Bid Proposal Form is made without previous understanding, agreement, or connection to any person, firm or corporation making a bid for the same item(s), and is in all respects fair, without outside control, collusion, fraud, or otherwise illegal action.
- b) Bid Cancellations or Change:
  College may cancel this agreement at any time with 30 days written notice.
  In the event of proration of the fund from which payment under which this agreement is to be made, the agreement will be subject to termination.
  The College reserves the right to purchase according to availability of
- c) **No Obligation:** The Invitation to Bid in no manner obligates the college to purchase any products or services offered until a contract is awarded and the successful bidder receives a valid purchase order from the college.
- d) Contract Termination/Cancellation:
  Payment shall be contingent upon the
  College's inspection of and
  satisfaction with completed work or
  materials. The college has the right to
  cancel any contract, for cause,
  including, but not limited to, the
  following: (1) failure to deliver within
  the terms of the contract; (2) failure of
  the product or service to meet
  specifications, conform to sample

quality, or to be delivered in good condition; (3) misrepresentation by vendor; (4) fraud, collusion, conspiracy, or other unlawful means of obtaining any contract with the state; (5) conflict of contract provisions with constitutional or statutory provisions of state or federal law; and (6) any other breach of contract. A written notification from the college to the vendor shall become effective thirty (30) days from the vendor's receipt of such notice. In the case of termination, only the portion of the contract satisfactorily performed before the date of termination will be due and payable to the vendor. A vendor who fails to satisfactorily honor the terms of the bid, may be excluded from consideration for future invitations to bid. After properly documenting the breach of contract, the college shall award the contract to the next lowest responsible and responsive bidder for the remaining of the duration of the contract.

e) **Disclosure of Bid Contents:** Bids shall be kept confidential until contracts are awarded. At that time, all bids and documents will be open to the public. All responses become a matter of public record at award. The college accepts no responsibility for maintaining confidentiality of any information submitted with response whether labeled confidential or not.

#### 6. VENDOR REQUIREMENTS

Governing Law: The vendor shall observe, perform and comply with or require compliance with all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations and all amendments thereto which in any manner may affect the operation and vendor's activities undertaken pursuant to this Agreement. The vendor shall also comply with all state and local building, fire, health, zoning laws, codes, and/or regulations that affect or that are applicable to vendor's activities and operations hereunder. The final agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama without giving effect to any choice or conflictof-law provisions or rules (whether of the State of Alabama or any other

jurisdiction) that would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than those of the State of Alabama. Any contract arising from this bid is subject to all laws of the State of Alabama. These terms and conditions shall supersede any contrary language in any agreement entered into by the parties. All terms shall be reduced to writing and will not rely on any oral terms, nor shall any oral terms or agreement be incorporated herein. As an entity of the State of Alabama, the parties recognize and agree that the College cannot and will not agree to indemnify any party to a contract resulting from this bid. In accordance with the recommendations of the Governor and the Attorney General of the State of Alabama, the parties shall consider settling all disputes arising from or related to this agreement by using appropriate forms of non-binding alternative dispute resolution.

# b) Personal Property or Contractual Services 41-16-57

The awarding authority in the purchase of or contract for personal property or contractual services shall give preference, provided there is no sacrifice or loss in price or quality, to commodities produced in Alabama or sold by Alabama persons, firms, or corporations. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no county official, county commission, school board, city council or city councilmen, or other public official, state board, or state agency charged with the letting of contracts or purchase of materials for the construction, modification, alteration, or repair of any publicly owned facility may specify the use of materials or systems by a sole source, unless: (1) The governmental body can document to the satisfaction of the

State of Alabama Building
Commission that the sole source
product or service is of an
indispensable nature, all other
viable alternatives have been
explored, and it has been
determined that only this product or
service will fulfill the function for
which the product is needed.
Frivolous features will not be
considered.

- (2) The sole source specification has been recommended by the architect or engineer of record and who also documents that there is no other product available and that the use of the requirement is of an indispensable nature and why.
  (3) All information substantiating the use of a sole source specification is documented in writing and is filed into the project file.
- c) Criminal Offenses: Organizations or individuals awarded the bid certify that no agent, employee or representative possessing a questionable moral character; a history of criminal activity affecting the area where service is to be provided; or a conviction for sexual offense; will have direct contact with students, faculty, or staff. Violation of this provision will result in the nullification of the bid agreement.
- d) In compliance with Act 2016-312, the contractor hereby certifies that it is not currently engaged in, and will not engage in, the boycott of a person or an entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which this state can enjoy open trade.
- e) Statement of Economic Interests:

  The awarded vendor is responsible for filing the Statement of Economic Interests with the Alabama Ethics Commission, if the awarded vendor is a public official, public employee, or if a member of the awarded vendor's household is a public official or employee. The awarded vendor is responsible for sending a copy of the

awarded contract to the Alabama Ethics Commission within ten (10) days after bid has been awarded. For more information concerning this requirement, please refer to the Alabama Ethics Commission Advisory Opinion 2001-29.

- f) General Liability Insurance:
  Successful bidder will be required to submit a copy of General Liability (umbrella) insurance. The copy must show amount limits for automobile, workmen's compensation, etc. (applicable for the delivery of materials, supplies, etc.)
- g) Permits and Licenses: Bidder shall, at its sole expense, procure and keep in effect all necessary permits and licenses required for its performance of the requested work or service.

  Successful bidder must provide a copy of current state, county or city business license, general contractor's license or applicable license as required by law.
- Alabama Relationship Disclosure h) **Statement:** All vendors must complete the Alabama Relationship Disclosure Statement. Act 2001-955 requires the disclosure statement to be completed and filed with all proposals, bids, contracts, or grant proposals to the State of Alabama in excess of \$5000. A Vendor Disclosure Statement is included with the bid proposal. It is the vendor's responsibility to follow the instructions included with the Disclosure Statement. A copy must be received by the college before the bid can be awarded. If the information on the form changes during the bid term, the vendor is required to submit a new form to the college.
- i) Alabama Immigration Law:

- j) Alabama Act Number 2006-557:
  Certification pursuant to Act Number 2006-557 Alabama Law (SECTION 41-4-116, CODE OF ALABAMA 1975) provides that every bid submitted and contract executed shall contain a certification that the vendor,

contractor, and all of its affiliates that makes sales for delivery into Alabama or lease for use in Alabama are registered, collecting, and remitting Alabama State and Local Sales, Use, and/or Lease Tax on all taxable sales and leases into Alabama. By submitting this bid, the bidder is hereby certifying that they are in full compliance with ACT NO. 2006-557. Vendors are not barred from bidding or entering into a contract pursuant to Section 41-4-116, and acknowledge that the awarding authority may declare the contract void if the certification is false.

- l) It is further agreed that if any provision of this Agreement shall contravene any statute of Constitutional provision, either now in effect of which may be enacted during the term of this Agreement, then the conflicting provision of the Agreement shall be deemed null and void.
- m) The bidder acknowledges, and agrees that its sole and exclusive remedy for any monetary claim or any claim for which the College has sovereign immunity that may arise from or relate to this Agreement is to file a claim with the Board of Adjustment of the State of Alabama. Any claim for equitable relief or for which the College does not have sovereign immunity shall be brought exclusively in the appropriate state or federal court situated in and/or covering Elmore County, Alabama.
